This session will explore recent advances in upper atmosphere (mesosphere–thermosphere) and ionosphere research at equatorial and low latitudes, focusing on features observed at different longitudinal sectors. Topics include ionospheric irregularities, gravity, tide and planetary wave propagations, mesosphere and thermosphere coupling. We invite observational and modeling studies covering both high and low solar activity, as well as geomagnetic storm effects.
