## XII Latin American Conference on Space Geophysics (COLAGE)

Announcement of the XII Latin American Conference on Space Geophysics that will be held at the <u>Cabanas Valles de Pucon</u> in Pucon, Chile, from 14-18 of December 2020 during the same week of the <u>total Eclipse that will occur the 14th of December 2020</u>. Weather permitting, the total eclipse of December 14 should be seen at the conference site.

The Latin American Association of Space Geophysics (Asociación Latinoamericana de Geofísica Espacial or ALAGE) was founded in 1988 and periodically organizes the Latin American Meeting of Space Geophysics (Congreso Latinoamericano de Geofísica Espacial or COLAGE). That is why, due to the difficulty of blocking more rooms, we would like to suggest the possibility of organizing in groups and share the cabins and apartments, so that we can accommodate more people close to the conference site.

Therefore, we ask everybody to be aware of these complications and be flexible about lodging and transportation during the time of the eclipse. This is a unique adventure that doesn't repeat very often.
