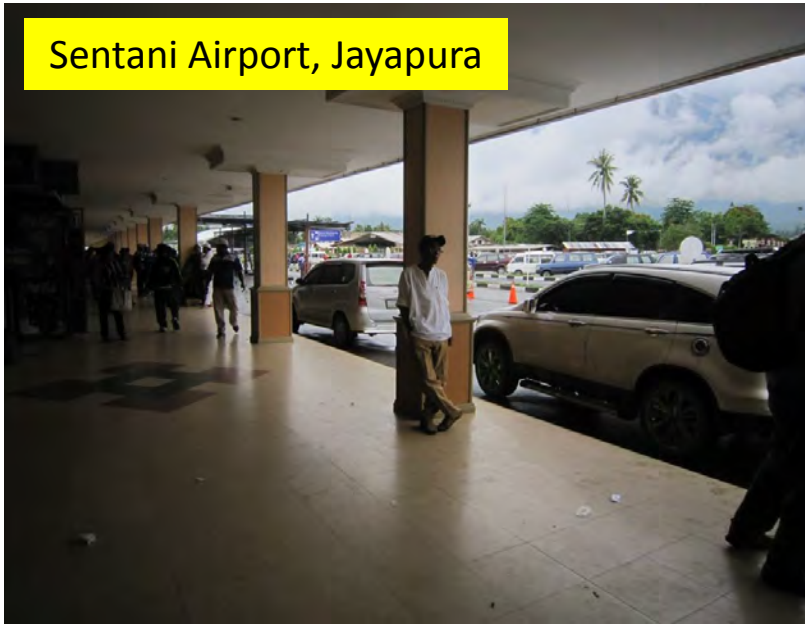

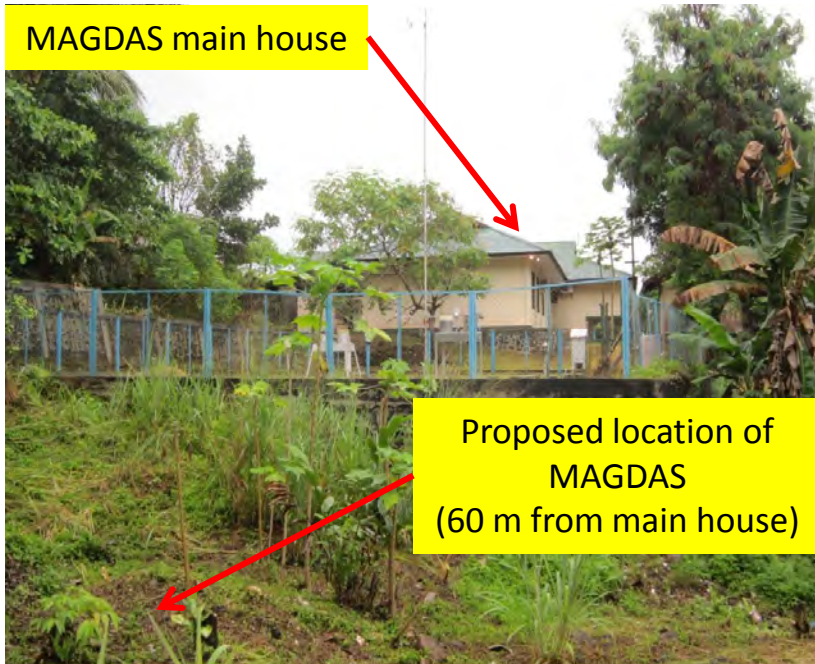

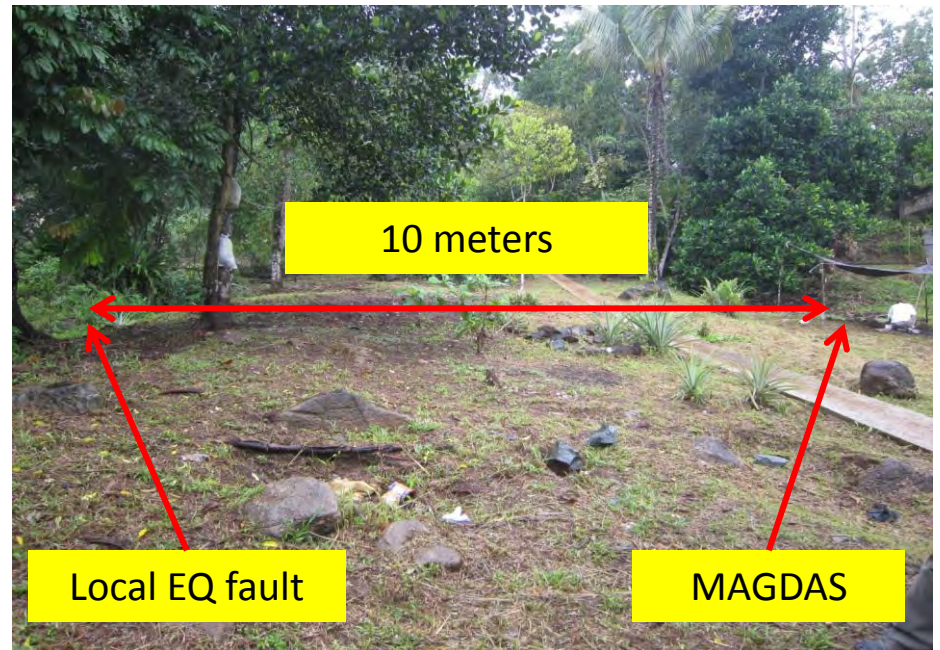

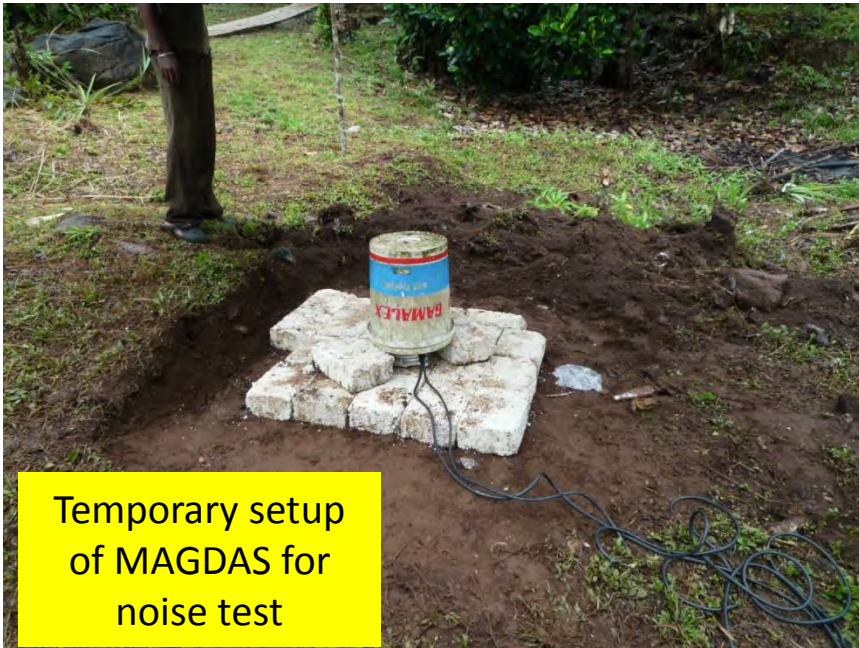


Proposed location of MAGDAS (60 m from main house)

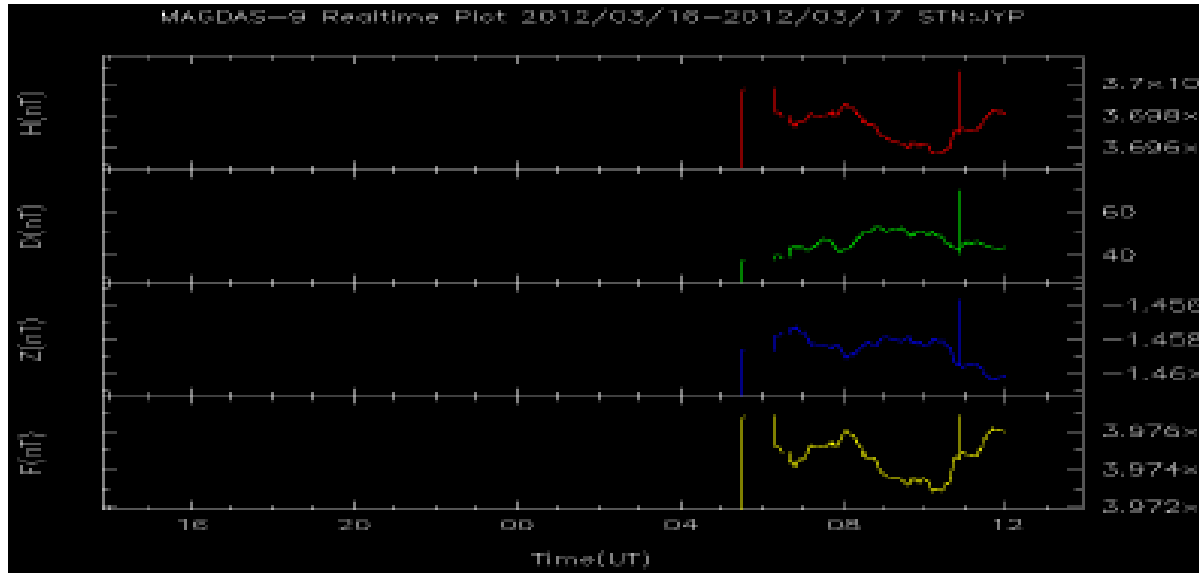
Temporary setup of MAGDAS for noise test



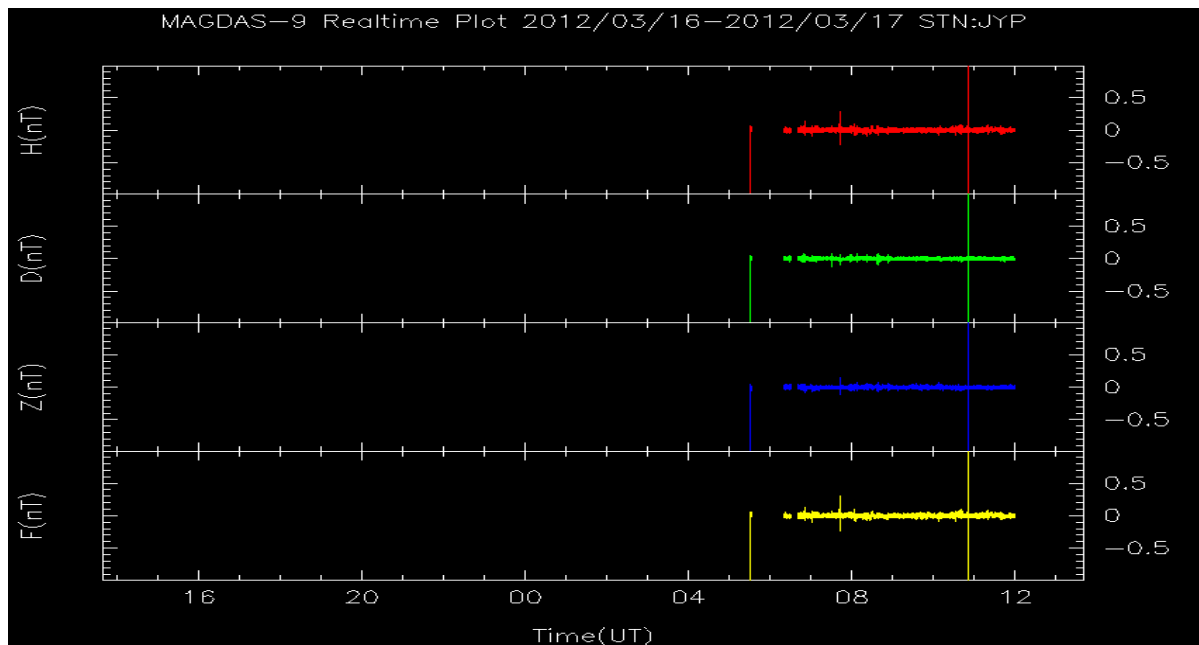

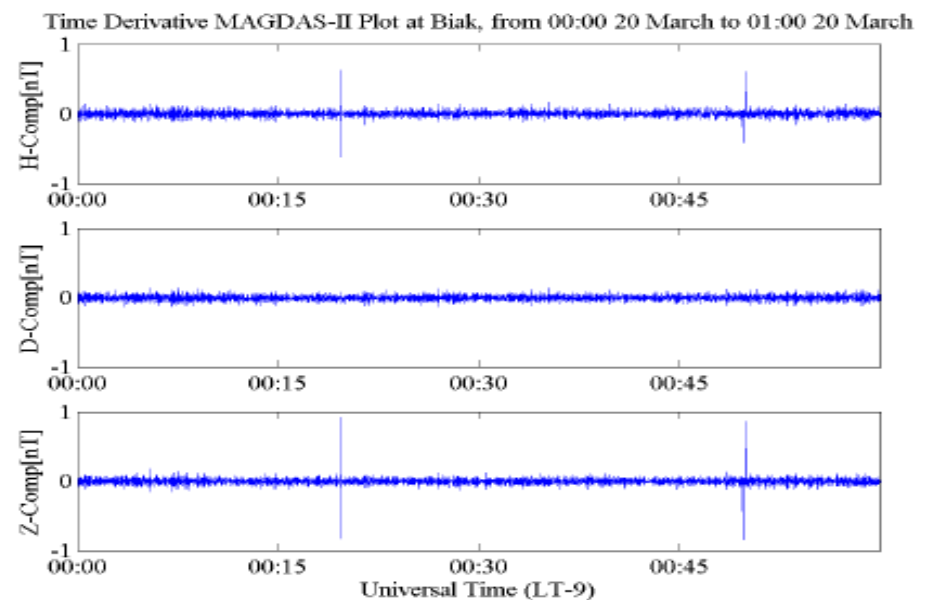

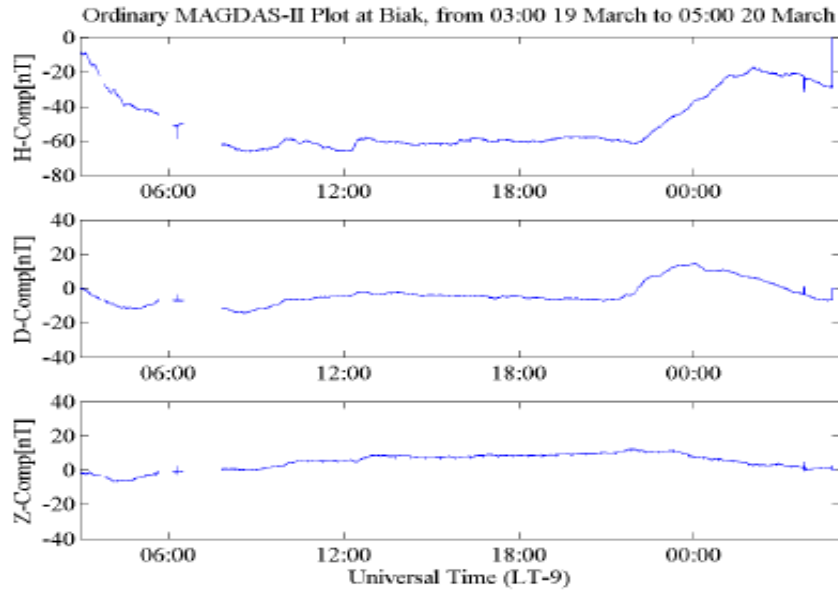
